CM/ECF Changes & Updates

This section includes information regarding changes and updates to CM/ECF events, menus and the way the system processes information.

In order to comply with IRS regulations, courts must begin to track "disputed ownership funds" pertaining to 28 U.S.C Section 1335. To comply with these changes, CM/ECF has been modified with the following events:

Motion for Interpleader Deposit (28 U.S.C. Section 1335)

New event found under Bankruptcy Events > Motions/Applications > Interpleader Deposit (28 U.S.C. Section 1335) and Adversary Events > Motions > Interpleader Deposit (28 U.S.C. Section 1335). This event will be used to deposit interpleader funds into the court's registry.

Motion for Interpleader Disbursement (28 U.S.C. Section 1335)

New event found under Bankruptcy Events > Motions/Applications > Interpleader Disbursement (28 U.S.C. Section 1335) and Adversary Events > Motions > Interpleader Disbursement (28 U.S.C. Section 1335). This will be used for the authorization of Interpleader Disbursements.
